



CERA Large Shelter House Reservation

General Rules:

Reservation fee is \$150 and is not refundable. If the reservation was made via the cerapark.org website or was made in person at the park you will be required to leave a cleaning deposit of \$50 when arriving at CERA park.

Upon arrival check in at the gatehouse, a designated person will go with you to inspect the cleanliness of the shelter house.

Inspection of the shelter house will again be required before the \$50 cleaning deposit check will be returned.

The shelterhouse must be cleaned including:

- Picking up cans, paper, cigarette butts, and food and placing refuse in the containers provided.
- Floors must be swept and picnic tables cleaned.

***If not properly cleaned before departure the cleaning deposit will be retained**

Picnic tables must be returned to the location they were in upon arrival unless notified by the person making the initial inspection.

Amplified music is allowed but if the park manager requests the volume be turned down or off, it must be done

The shelter house must be vacated by midnight.

When entering the park, have your non-member guests check in with security at the gatehouse. Directions will be given to the designated shelter house upon request.

The shelter house can be reserved for family events, such as Graduation Parties, Birthday Celebrations, Wedding Celebrations, and Family reunions along with other family related events. Community organizations, Boy and Girl Scouts, 4-H and similar organizations are also welcome to use the CERA park shelters. Events that are fundraising, religious or political in nature will not be allowed at CERA Park. Please see the general park rules for overall park regulations.
